This winter has seen the start of a few projects around the ecology centre

Small Pond Refresh - Clearing the pond behind the allotments has already begun. We'll gently tidy, enrich the soil, and plant native species for improved cover and habitat, as well as Planting ferns, primroses, foxgloves, hellebores and a mix of bulbs, crocuses, Scilla, fritillaries and snowdrops to create early colour for pollinators 🐝🦋🐞.
